Check In and departure:

Check-in will begin at **2:00 p.m.** on the day of your arrival. **Do not arrive at the Registration Gazebo before this time.** **STAY in your vehicle** upon arrival at the Registration Gazebo. Someone will come to your vehicle, obtain your confirmation letter and will then bring your Welcome Packet and Welcome Gift to you. Your cabin assignment will be on the front of your packet envelope. You may then proceed to that cabin and unpack. After unpacking your needs at your cabin, drive your vehicle back to the Parking Lot behind the Registration Gazebo. Be sure to lock it securely. No vehicles may be parked at your cabin without camp authorization.

For those departing on any day, departure time is 12:00 noon.

In Case of Emergency:

If anyone needs to contact you at camp in case of an emergency, the camp telephone number is **(410) 457-4228**.

What to Bring:

A check-list has been included as a reminder to you of some of the most important items to bring to camp. All of the cabins are equipped with running water and electricity, i.e. hot water, showers, toilets, and electrical outlets. You may want to include a warm shirt if the weather is chilly, cameras. Meals and beverages are included but you may wish to bring some of your personal favorites.

If you have a talent, please plan to be in our talent show. Bring your music or instrument or whatever it is that your performance may require. The talent show has limitless possibilities.

If you plan to participate in the Flea Market, bring any items you wish to sell

(including your own hobby creations) -- and, of course, money for those items you can't resist buying, as well as Bingo during the week and the end of the week Raffle. The Flea Market presents a great opportunity to share your artsy talents and hobbies with your fellow naturists and to make a buck or two. If you belong to a local gay naturist group, bring your club banner or flag to display. Cabin decorations are encouraged and fun and add to the festive atmosphere of camp. Bring any of your wildest decorating ideas to add to the festivities. Also, DO NOT forget your costumes for the daily Happy Hour theme parties! You could possibly win a cash prize!

Directions: Camp Ramblewood, 2564 Silver Road, Darlington, MD 21034

*Camp Ramblewood is located just off Interstate 1-95. Traveling I-95 north from the Washington, DC-Baltimore area or south (I-95) from Philadelphia, proceed to the Havre De Grace, MD exit (#89). Turn South (West) onto Route 155 towards Churchville and Bel Air; proceed on Route 155 for three miles. Turn Right onto Route 161 and proceed five miles into Darlington. Make a sharp Right onto Shuresville Road. Proceed about one-and-a-half miles on Shuresville Road and watch for Silver Road on your right. Enter Silver Road and proceed a half-mile into Camp Ramblewood. It is always advisable to visit www.mapquest.com ahead of time or to stop at the Maryland Welcome Center and pick up an official highway map to familiarize yourself with where you are going. If you get lost, you may telephone the camp at **(410) 457-4228** for additional directions.*

Gathering Accommodations and What to Bring

The IMEN Gathering is held in a spacious campground in rural Maryland. You will be spending a lot of time outdoors in the sunlight and walking on grass and gravel. Bring plenty of footwear for walking on rough and unfamiliar terrain. You will want to bring a hat or visor and sunglasses and plenty of sun block. At night, you may want a flashlight to help you get around.

You will be rooming in NON-air-conditioned cabins, usually with around 7 other men. You will be supplied a twin-size bed. The beds have a Tempur-Pedic mattress, but you will need to bring your own bedding*, in the form of sheets, pillow(s) and blanket(s) or sleeping bag. It will be warm during the day, but it can also be warm in the cabins at night. Consider bringing a small electric fan with you for your own comfort.

Bring your own bath towels and toiletries. For hygienic and comfort reasons, bring something to sit on in the dining hall and evening events. Small hand towels work well. Metal chairs can become surprisingly cool.

You should only need cash to: (a) purchasing items at the Flea Market, (b) purchasing raffle tickets, (c) playing Bingo, or (d) contributing toward the IMEN collection for the staff (“Thank You”) near the end of the Gathering. **The Camp staff is one of the reasons our gathering venue is such a great place – they take such good care of us!**

Athletic equipment (not just jock straps)

Special equipment/handouts, etc, if you will be leading or participating in a Workshop

Portable fan

Cabin Decorations
